On behalf of everyone at Auckland Transport, we hope this letter finds you and your whānau well.

As part of our work to improve the safety of Auckland's roads, we are planning changes to encourage safer speeds in your area.

The work we're doing

We're doing this work to maintain and improve your neighbourhood and to keep you safe. The drawing shows where we'll be working.

The changes we are planning:

• Install a driver feedback sign on Broadlands Drive. This is a sign that lights up to display the speed of the driver to remind them to choose safe and appropriate speeds.

How this will benefit your neighbourhood

Auckland Transport is taking a Vision Zero approach to road safety. This means we are striving to have zero deaths or serious injuries on our transport system by 2050. To achieve this, we are working to create a more forgiving road network that recognises that we're all human and make mistakes. We've identified this location as part of our work to introduce safer speeds on Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland's roads. Installing a driver feedback sign will encourage safer speeds in your local area.

What happens next

Our contractors will send notices to residents or businesses affected by works 48 hours before it starts. We may need to delay the work or make other plans if the weather is poor or the contractor changes. If this happens, we will contact you again.

We anticipate these signs will be installed during February to March 2023.
